PAYMENT TERMS

Discounts are allowed as stated on the invoices if paid by the 10th of the month following billing, Net 15th of month and considered past due thereafter. All payments are payable at 2526 N. Stallings Drive, Nacogdoches, Nacogdoches County, Texas. It is further agreed that each past due invoice will be charged a service charge of 1.5% per

month, not to exceed 18% per annum. It is also understood and agreed that if this sale is placed in the hands of an attorney, and/or collection agency, the Buyer agrees to pay all expenses, including court costs, legal and administrative expenses, attorney and/or collection agency fees paid or incurred by ELLIOTT ELECTRIC SUPPLY.
